The documents would certify that the applicant meets the (5) five-year residency requirement (the five-year period of residence is the period ending with the date that application is received in the relevant Government Office). The applicant's signature must be witnessed by a Notary Public who will thereafter affix his/her signature, seal and date the affidavit.
